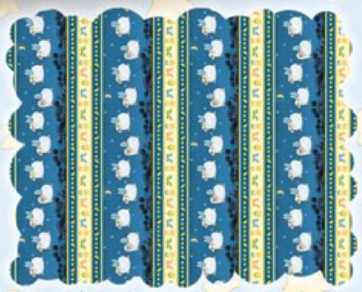

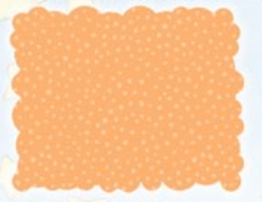

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Quilt #1 Instructions

approximate size : 43 1/2" x 58 1/2"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 1 - 28 1/2" x 42 1/2"

Fabric E - cut 3 - 3 3/8" strips, subcut 32 - 3 3/8" squares
cut 2 - 3" x 3" squares

Fabric G - cut 6 - 1 3/4" strips (4-patches)

Fabric I - cut 3 - 3 3/8" strips, subcut 32 - 3 3/8" squares
cut 2 - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" corner squares

BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

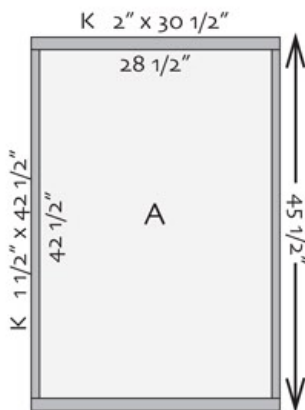
Fabric K - **Inner Border - cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" (Sides) and cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 2 - 2" x 30 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Outer Border - cut 6 - 2" strips, sew end to end then subcut: 2 - 2" x 55 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 43 1/2"

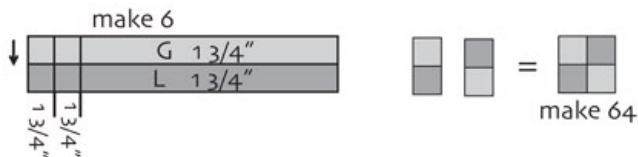
Fabric L - cut 6 - 1 3/4" strips (4-patches)

2. Piecing Order:

- Sew **K** 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" to both SIDES of center panel **A**, then sew **K** 2" x 30 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM. ** (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **K** borders slightly larger, sew around **A**, then trim center block to measure 30 1/2" x 45 1/2".)



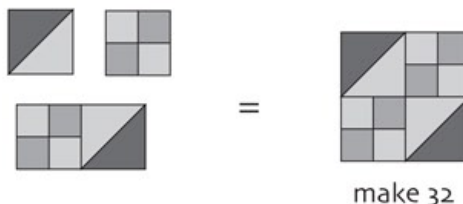
- Make 64 - 2 1/2" finished (3" unf.) 4-Patches. First, sew 6 pairs of **G** and **L** 1 3/4" strips, side by side. Press toward **L**. Subcut 128 - 1 3/4" segments. Then sew segments together for 64 4-Patches.



- Make 64 - 2 1/2" finished (3" unf.) Half Square Triangle units. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 32 **E** 3 3/8" squares. Pair **E** and **I** squares right sides together, match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press toward **I**. Repeat for all 64 units.



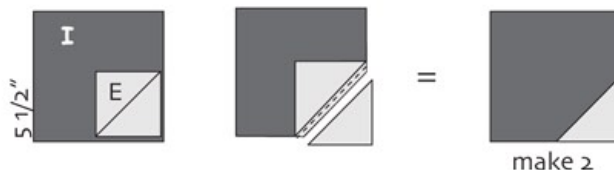
- Make 32 - 5" finished (5 1/2" unf.) Chain Blocks by sewing 4-patches and Half Square Triangle units together by rows according to the diagram.



- Sew 9 chain blocks together for both SIDE borders. Sew 6 blocks together for the TOP border and sew 8 blocks together for the BOTTOM border according to the diagram on the next page.

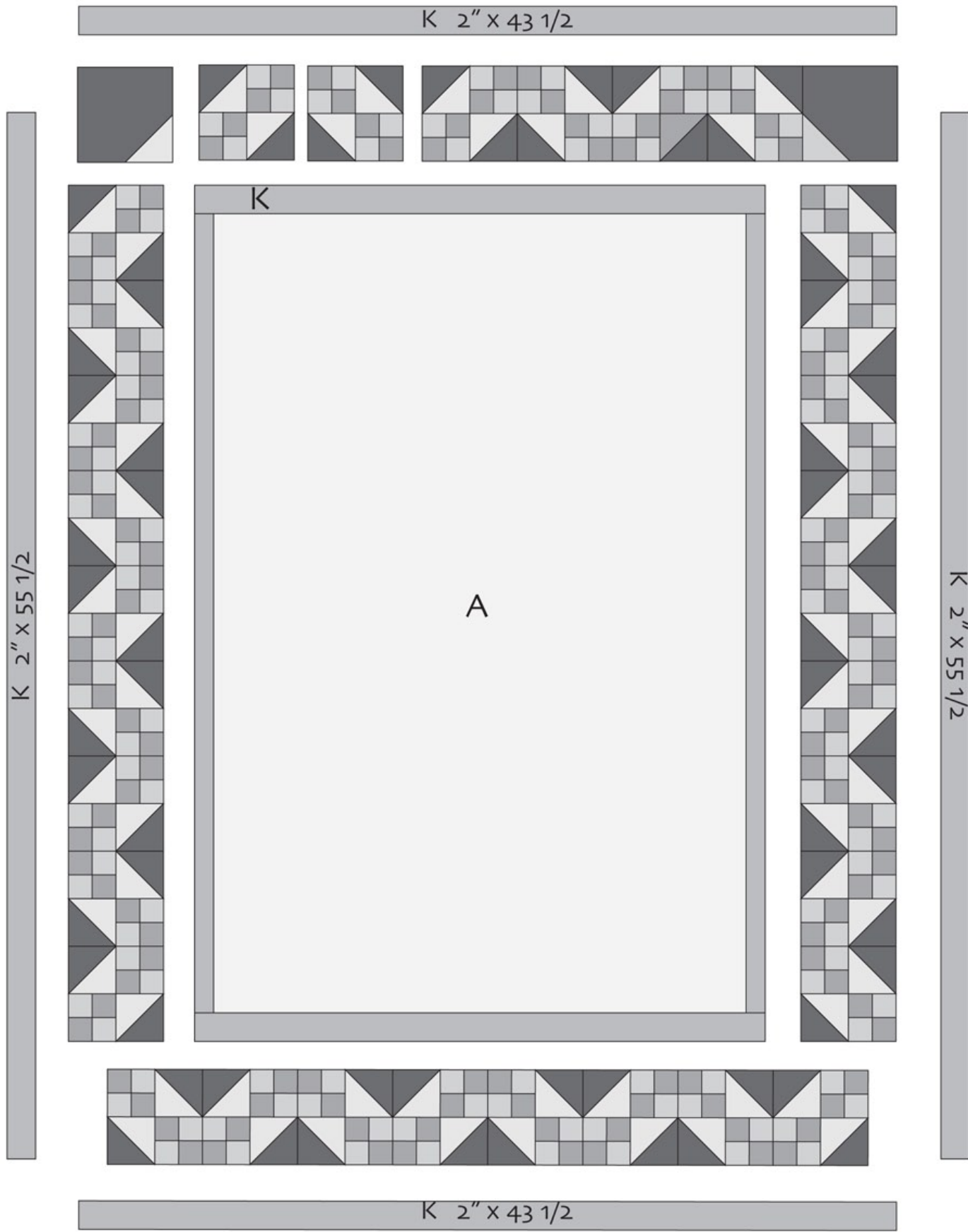
- Make 2 - 5" finished (5 1/2" unf.) corner blocks. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of two **E** 3" squares. Place one **E** square over one corner of **I** 5 1/2" square, right sides together.

Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam and press outward. Next, sew a corner block to both ends of the TOP chain border according to the diagram on the next page.



- Sew SIDE chain borders to the quilt, then sew TOP and BOTTOM chain borders.

- Sew 2" **K** borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.



8. Quilt #1 measures approximately $43 \frac{1}{12}'' \times 58 \frac{1}{2}''$. Make backing (**Fabric J**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!

Quilt #2 Instructions

approximate size : 39" x 55"

Page Three

1. Cut the following:

Fabric B - cut 2 different borders lengthwise:

10 1/2" x 36 1/2"

Fabric D - cut 12 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares (extra fabric is allowed if centering the design is desired.)

Fabric E - cut 3 - 3 7/8" strips, subcut 24 - 3 7/8" squares

Fabric F - cut 5 - 3 7/8" strips, subcut 48 - 3 7/8" squares

BINDING - cut 5 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric G - cut 3 - 3 7/8" strips, subcut 24 - 3 7/8" squares

Fabric H - cut 9 - 1 3/4" strips, sew end to end then subcut:

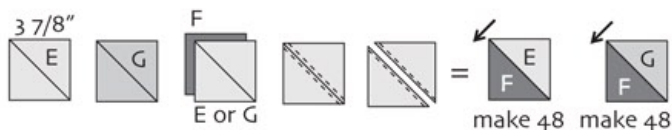
4 - 1 3/4" x 36 1/2"

2 - 1 3/4" x 52 1/2"

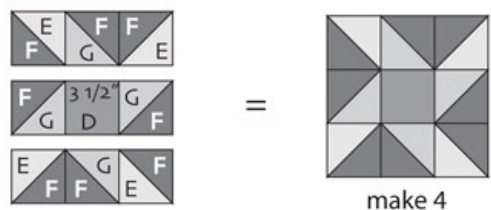
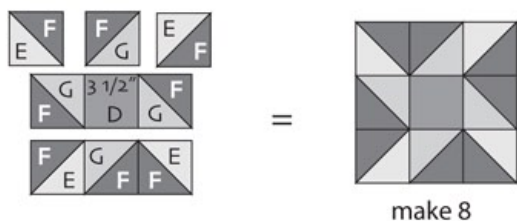
2 - 1 3/4" x 39"

2. Piecing Order:

- Draw a diagonal line on the backside of 24 **E** and 24 **G** 3 7/8" squares. Pair each **E** and **G** square together with an **F** 3 7/8" square, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press toward **Fabric F**. Cut on the line to separate units. Press toward **Fabric F**. Make 48 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unfin.) **E/F** and 48 **G/F** units.



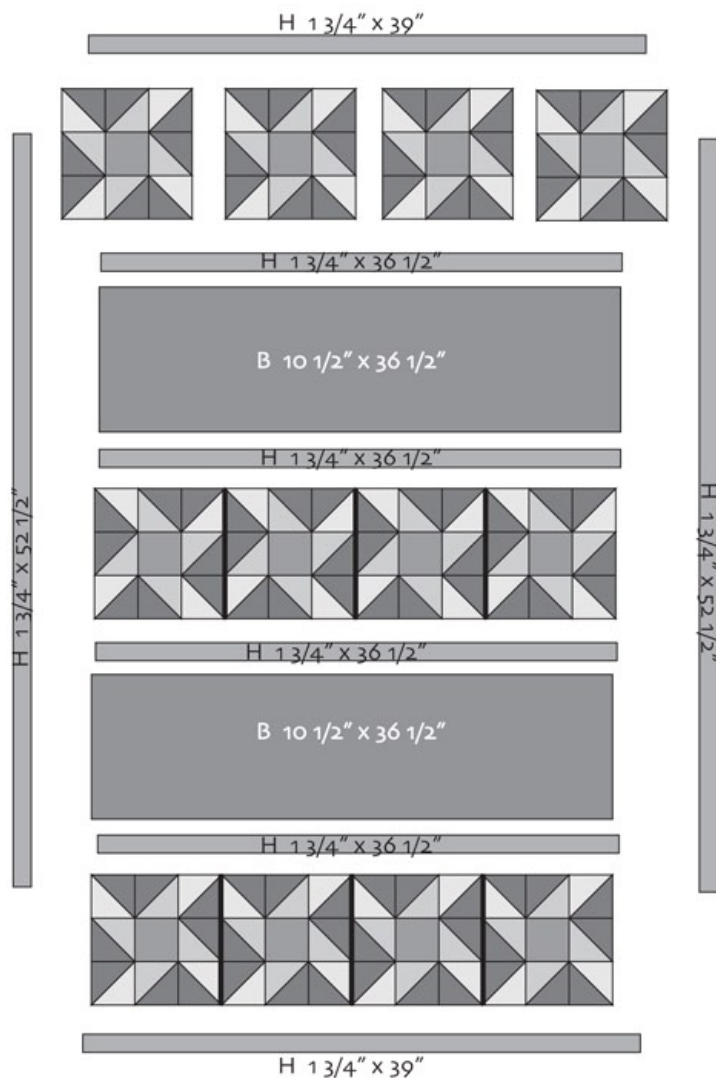
- Make 12 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unfin.) pieced blocks. Sew blocks together by rows according to the diagram (8 blocks for the top and bottom rows and 4 blocks for the middle row).



- Sew 4 blocks side by side for each top and bottom rows. Sew 4 blocks side by side for the middle row according to the diagram.

- Sew rows of blocks, two **B** 10 1/2" x 36 1/2" and four **H** 1 3/4" x 36 1/2" together for the quilt center according to the diagram.

- Sew **H** 1 3/4" x 52 1/2" to the SIDES of the quilt, then sew **H** 1 3/4" x 39" to the TOP and BOTTOM.



- Quilt #2 measures approximately 39" x 55". Layer and baste together top, batting and backing (**Fabric C**). Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**) and enjoy!!
