

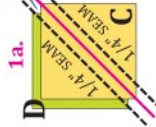
SAMPLE KEY/SKU QTY CUT

A	Gone Fishing Panel 3570-33 Multi Yellow (24" WIDE)	1 Panel 1-1/3 YD	(13) FUSSY CUT 6-1/2" squares.
B	Fish Fandango 3576-55 Royal	1 YD	(6) 6-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (26) 4-3/4" ON POINT squares. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; BINDING.
C	Bubbles 3573-30 Yellow	2/3 YD	(6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (44) 4-1/2" squares. FROM SQUARES subcut (20) squares diagonally twice to yield (80) QST and (8) squares once diagonally to yield (16) HST. (4) 2" x WOF strips; BORDER.
D	Frolic Circles 3574-44 Lime	2/3 YD	(6) 4-1/2" squares. (2) 4-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (14) 4-3/4" squares. (4) 2" x WOF strips; BORDER.
E	Ribbet Geo 3575-10 Red	2/3 YD	(10) 4-1/2" on squares. (4) 4" x wof strips. Subcut (40) 2-5/8" on point squares.

QST=QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE | HST=HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE | WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS: Place right sides together (1) **C** and **D** 4-1/2" square, with **C** on top. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of **C** square and sew 1/4" seam on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line (1a.). Press open the HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCKS towards **D**. Square blocks to 3-7/8" (1b.). Repeat steps for **CE** blocks (1c.).

2. Cut **CD** blocks in half diagonally to yield (2) **CD** triangles. Make (24) **CD** and (40) **CE** triangles (2a-b.). Set (16) **CE** triangles aside for outer border.

3. Block Two: Take (2) **CD** and **CE** triangles and sew to each side of (1) **B** 4-3/4" ON POINT square. *Note pattern direction of B fabric and placement of units.* Square block to 6-1/2". Make 3 of each block as shown below.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM to sew BLOCKS ONE and Two in rows of 5. Make 5 rows. Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.

BORDERS Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure cut size of **C** and **D** border strips. We've included our measurements in the instructions below.

5. Cut (2) **C** 2" x WOF strips to length of quilt top (30-1/2") and sew to each side of quilt top. Repeat for top and bottom of quilt top, measuring width of quilt top (33-1/2").

6. Add **D** (1) 2" x (33-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top and (1) **D** 2" x (36-1/2") strips to top and bottom.

PIECED OUTER BORDER

7. SIDE SETTING TRIANGLES: Sew (1) **C** 4-1/2" QST to both top sides of (1) **E** 2-5/8" square. Make 40 **CEC** triangles.



8. END UNITS: Sew (2) **CE** triangles and (1) **CEC** triangle to **B** and **D** 4-3/4" ON POINT squares. Refer to diagrams below. *Note pattern direction of B fabric.*



9. BORDER UNITS: Sew (2) **CEC** triangles to opposite sides of (1) **D** and **B** ON POINT 4-3/4" squares. Watch pattern direction of **B** units. Refer to diagrams.



10. CORNERSTONE BLOCKS: Sew (1) **C** 4-1/2" HST to each side of (1) **B** 4-3/4" ON POINT square. Square **BC** block to 6-1/2". Make 2 **BC** blocks. Repeat for **CD** block.

FOR STEPS 11-13 REFER CONTINUOUSLY TO QUILT DIAGRAM AND QUILT PHOTO.

11. Sew **BORDER UNITS** and **END UNITS** together to make **PIECED BORDER**. Make 4 borders strips. Trim **PIECED BORDERS** to 6-1/2" x 36-1/2". *Note B pattern direction.*

12. Sew left and right **PIECED BORDERS** to each side of quilt top.

13. Add **BC** and **CD** **CORNERSTONES** to remaining **PIECED BORDERS**. Sew **BC-BORDER STRIP-CD** to top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Place backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.

FINISHED SIZE: 48" SQUARE.
