

December Quilting Fabric Sale: From Dec 1- 19 all quilting fabric will be 25% off and those bolts that are already marked to 40% off will go to half off during this time. A great time to stock up so we don't have so many folds to count for the upcoming inventory.

Holiday Hours: We will be closed on November 26, December 25 and 26 and January 1 and 2. We will also be closing at 3:00 on November 25, December 24 and December 31. Please have a blessed holiday, whatever you celebrate.

Row By Row pattern and kit: Our Friendly Froggy row pattern and kit are now on our web site and available for purchase there and in the store while they last. Remember the kit includes the pattern, buttons for embellishment, ribbon for frog's tongue and the fabric for the front. The green strips for the lily pads are cut to the correct width and just need to be crosscut. It makes a nice size for a table runner if you don't want all your rows in a quilt. The next Row by Row Experience will have a theme of "Home Sweet Home" and will start on June 21 running until the day after Labor Day.

TECHNIQUE TIP: Sore Fingers

When you quilt, do you have a problem with sore fingers from needle pricks? Or do your threads snag on your rough skin? Here are some tips: Try to quilt regularly so you form a callous on the tip. Use a thimble on the third finger of each hand. Wash your dishes using rubber gloves. Soaking hands in bathtub or swimming pool will also soften your callouses. Use surgical tape, a small piece of black electrical tape or paper tape (get at drug store) on fingers that are under the guilt. You can also cut the tips off old leather gloves to use on your fingers. Alternate which finger you use underneath. Use a bit of Mycitracin on sore fingers at bedtime and they will feel better the next day. You can also soak fingers in Listerine mouthwash for a couple of minutes twice a day and smooth out the rough places with an emery board. (Listerine and white vinegar, 1 cup each, in 2-3 cups of warm water makes a great exfoliation soak for feet, too) Use a thimble to push the needle and rubber finger cots to pull it through. Alternate hand quilting with piecing or other activities to rest your fingers when they get sore or tired. Try not to leave a lot of quilting that has to be done at the last minute when you have a deadline - plan ahead. Soaking your fingers in chlorine bleach will make them tough. Using alum (also available at the drug store) on fingers will toughen your callouses. Use a leather thimble with a large metal guard on your thumb in addition to the thimble on your index finger. New Skin used on your fingers will act like a liquid band-aid. The best thing you can do is drink lots of water to keep from getting dry skin in the first place. When hands are dry they are most susceptible to injury and take longer to heal. Try Gloves in a Bottle (found at Fiberworks) to keep hands from getting rough, especially during the winter. This product does not leave an oily residue so you can stitch right after you apply it. Wear gloves in the winter so your hands don't get chapped. These tips come from various people who have found they work for them.

These are some of the classes we have offered before: counted cross-stitch, beyond cross-stitch which would include adding specialty stitches, stamped cross-stitch/embroidery, canvaswork - needlepoint, hardanger, pulled thread, drawn thread, bargello, petite point on silk gauze, knotted work, smocking, temari balls, knitting, crochet, duplicate stitch, myreshka drawn work, tatting, bridge stitching (darning stitch), beadwork (peyote, herringbone, right angle weave, square stitch, brick stitch), huck embroidery (Swedish weaving), Brazilian embroidery, silk ribbon embroidery, punch needle, locker hook, stumpwork, blackwork, beginning piecing for quilting, paper piecing for quilting, fusible applique, crazy quilts, bargello quilts, felt applique, free lace for scarves/shawls, framing and mounting tips, finishing pillows, finishing standups, finishing in a box shape, tassels, etuis, stitch notebooks. 


