TECHNIQUE TIP: 10 Machine Piecing Tips

- 1. Some sewing machines have rulers on the base in the front. If yours doesn't, place a self stick ruler at the front edge of the mat or table under your machine.
- 2. Use a size 11 or 80/12 sewing machine needle. Set stitch length for 12-14 stitches per inch (2.0-2.5) or use 14-16 (1.0-1.5) for seams that will be pressed open.
- 3. A sharp sewing machine needle is essential. If your needle begins to be noisy thunks when it travels through the fabric it is dull. Replace it.
- 4. Use a straight stitch throat plate to make machine stitching more precise when you are not zig-zaging.
- 5. If your machine has a slow speed, use it to make more accurate curves or when doing lots of pivots or removing of pins.
- 6. It is not necessary to backstitch any seam that will be crossed by another line of machine stitching.
- 7. If you have a "needle down" on your machine, use it to make chain piecing easier. Chain stitching is when you are sewing several pieces together by feeding one in after another without stopping to cut the thread in between.
- 8. When sewing angled, pointed pieces, begin stitching at the wide end of the patch so the point doesn't get caught down in the feed dogs.
- 9. Be sure you are using an exact ¼" seam. Use tape on your machine to mark the location if there isn't one.
- 10. A computer mouse pad under your foot pedal prevents it from traveling across the floor.



These are some of the classes we have offered before: counted cross-stitch, beyond cross-stitch which would include adding specialty stitches, stamped cross-stitch/embroidery, canvaswork - needlepoint, hardanger, pulled thread, drawn thread, bargello, petite point on silk gauze, knotted work, smocking, temari balls, knitting, crochet, duplicate stitch, myreshka drawn work, tatting, bridge stitching (darning stitch), beadwork (peyote, herringbone, right angle weave, square stitch, brick stitch), huck embroidery (Swedish weaving), Brazilian embroidery, silk ribbon embroidery, punch needle, locker hook, stumpwork, blackwork, beginning piecing for quilting, paper piecing for quilting, fusible applique, crazy quilts, bargello quilts, felt applique, free lace for scarves/shawls, framing and mounting tips, finishing pillows, finishing standups, finishing in a box shape, tassels, etuis, stitch notebooks.
