


January special: Jan 20-23 buy one pattern at regular price and get another pattern half off. All techniques included.



March Special: March 17-20 buy one fat quarter and get another one 1/2 off.



front. Sign up now! We have a half sized model in the shop for you to see the project. Stop in!



TECHNIQUE TIP: Sewing Machine Care

How often do you clean out your bobbin lint? Here is a suggestion as to process from one of my suppliers. First unplug your machine and remove the needle and presser foot. (Check your owner's manual if you don't know how to do any of these steps.) Next open the bobbin area and remove the bobbin. Brush any lint or thread bits out of this area. Then remove the needle plate and left out the bobbin case. Many machines come with a lint brush but I also use a small pair of tweezers to help get in the tight spots in the back areas. Brush out all lint accumulated here - probably a big wad, and do between and around the feed dogs, too. Some machines you can use a can of compressed air to whoosh out lint but confer with your manual as to advisability of using this. IF NECESSARY oil your machine now. Only do this if your manual tells you to as all machines do not need to be oiled. When everything is cleaned out replace all the pieces. Plug your machine back in, turn it on and test your reassembly. It should run smoothly and quietly. Insert a new needle and you are ready to begin again. Remember this is not a substitute for having your machine professionally cleaned and checked over about every two years. The brand of thread that you use will affect the amount of lint that you store up. The less expensive threads that are made from a short staple will cause more lint. Remember to replace your needle when it gets dull. You can hear a difference as it goes through the material - almost a clunking sound when the sharpness is gone. It also may start to snag when it is not going through the fabric cleanly. Take good care of your sewing machine and it should serve you well for many years.



CLASSES: If you would like to learn some specific technique or work on a specific project, let me know. We will schedule a custom class at your time choice and expertise level.

These are some of the classes we have offered before: counted cross-stitch, beyond cross-stitch which would include adding specialty stitches, stamped cross-stitch/embroidery, canvaswork - needlepoint, hardanger, pulled thread, drawn thread, bargello, petite point on silk gauze, knotted work, smocking, temari balls, knitting, crochet, duplicate stitch, myreshka drawn work, tatting, bridge stitching (darning stitch), beadwork (peyote, herringbone, right angle weave, square stitch, brick stitch), huck embroidery (Swedish weaving), Brazilian embroidery, silk ribbon embroidery, punch needle, locker hook, stumpwork, blackwork, beginning piecing for quilting, paper piecing for quilting, fusible applique, crazy quilts, bargello quilts, felt applique, free lace for scarves/shawls, framing and mounting tips, finishing pillows, finishing standups, finishing in a box shape, tassels, etuis, stitch notebooks. Just let me know your pleasure.

"Sit and Stitch" will "officially "be on February 12th and March 12th from 1-5 and January 22nd, February 26th and March 26th from 5-8. Thank you to The Nebbly Needle and Cherished Stitches for sharing their free designs for the newsletter.




