Row By Row On the Go: This event continues through September 5th. At



each participating shop that you visit you can get a free row pattern that you use to make a guilt. The first person that brings in a finished quilt before the end of October, using at least 8 different rows, will get the store prize of 25 fat quarters and we will display your work of art so all can see. On the Grow patterns are only free during the active hop period but will be available for purchase on November 1. Kits are ready for purchase that include the fabric and buttons for the row, get yours while they still last. If we have any left they will be put on the web site catalog after October 31st when the hibernation period is over. We also have kits for the Row By Row Junior pattern Friendship Bracelets for the younger set. This is an easy pattern for beginner level quilters - under 18yr. - so bring those kids or grandkids along with you. The first five young people who bring in the finished row get a ribbon and certificate of completion. You must be present in the store to get one of either free row pattern. Last year more than 3100 stores across the US and Canada did this event. Our new license plate can be purchased at any time "Piece in my Heart".



Collective Stitch: Our "Postcard from Iowa" pattern designed by Three Jars Full is available for free until August 31st Remember to put your name in a drawing for a free copy of the book that has all the patterns from participating shops when the hop is over. If you don't win but would still like a book, they are \$30.00 for all 25 designs.

TECHNIQUE TIP:

Whether you do your own finishing or take it to someone else, you need to consider how much extra ground fabric you will need to add when choosing a size for your project. A framed piece is usually mounted by pinning or lacing to a piece of foam core. You will need to allow enough fabric to go around the foam core to the back plus however much you want to show on the front around the stitched design or be covered up by a mat. If you chose not to use a mat 2" around is usually enough. If you use one mat 3" around should do. If you use a double mat or want a fairly wide mat showing then add 4" around. If you aren't sure what you will do, go for add 6" total.

If you are going to do a pillow finish, add the amount you want to show around the design and enough for a seam, usually the 4" total is good. You might want to allow extra if you have trouble getting your design in the middle of your fabric. (The surest way to do this is to find the center of your fabric by folding in half both ways or measuring. Then find the center of your pattern and start stitching in the middle.) If you are making an ornament or a small item like a scissor fob you can allow less but remember that a little extra space is easier to work with than too little.

Also check the backside of your needlework, especially with cross stitch, to be sure there are no long thread ends. When you end a thread, run it under in the back of 4-5 previous stitches and cut the rest off. If you leave tails on the back, it is possible to see a shadow silhouette on the front if these peek out from beyond the design, especially with a light colored ground. This also applies to carrying a darker color from one area to another on the back where there is no stitching. End off and start again to avoid thread trails.

On needlepoint ornaments or pillows, it is helpful to stitch 2-3 rows of tent stitch around the design in a coordinating color. This gives the finisher a place to sew right next to the design and not have any of the background canvas show or loose the outside stitch of the design in the seam. Plan ahead – your finisher will appreciate it or you will have an easier job.


SIT AND STITCH - COME AND JOIN US!





