**New Block of the Month:** I am looking for a pattern for next year with a variety of different sampler blocks. If you might be interested in doing one this style, let me know.




# **TECHNIQUE TIP: Interfacing**

Need a little stiffer project? There are many choices for interfacing to make your piece "stand up". First you need to decide if you want a fusible (with an iron) or a sew-in kind. And then you will need to choose how heavy you want your support. I like to use a woven soft weight when I do T-shirt quilts as the shirts are stretchy and the interfacing keeps edges straight and uncurled when you sew the blocks together. Here's what the Heat and Bond label has to say: "Quickly and easily add stability and crispness to fabrics and reduce fraying. Works well with many fabrics including chiffon, cotton, denim, fleece, flannel, satin, tweed, wool and more." They list four kinds. 1. Tricot which adds soft, flexible support to all knits and woven fabrics. 2. Weft combines strength and stretch to all types of fabrics. 3. Woven has minimal stretch and adds stability and strength to fabrics. 4. Non-woven has minimal shrinkage and adds stability to fabrics. Most of the lighter weights of interfacing will be white and 20-22" wide. There are some that are available in black (looks like gray to me). Non-woven comes in feather and light weights for dresses and bouses of light fabric, medium weight for all purpose use, shirt weight for shirt and jacket construction, craft and extra firm for craft projects like wallets, fabric bowls and home décor projects, fleece for adding body and loft to applique work, wall hangings, costumes and home décor, and quilter's 2"grid for easy piecing of watercolor, photo mosaic and other small patch quilts. Most will be machine washable and dry cleanable. Read the directions that come with your chosen interfacing for applying it to your fabric.
